

Urbana Park District Garden Service:

Delight in the harvest of food grown by your own hands!

Registration for the 2011 Garden Season has begun. Rentable garden plots are available at both Meadowbrook and now Victory Park. We provide water, wheelbarrows and hoses. You supply your own tools, seeds and labor. A garden supervisor is available to assist gardeners with questions or concerns.

2011 Growing Season: March 6–November 6

Gardeners can begin as soon as they have received their plot number confirmation. Remember **plot numbers are in the SOUTHEAST Corner**. Refer to the plot map on the Garden Kiosk for guidance.

Full and Half Plot Gardeners must have their plots cleared of all plant and non-plant material and returned to a level state by 4pm November 6th. Perennial Gardeners that do not plan on returning must also clear their plots.
