

Urbana Park District Garden Service:

Delight in the harvest of food grown by your own hands!

Registration for the 2012 Garden Season has begun. Rentable garden plots are available at both Meadowbrook and Victory Park (*for neighborhood residents only*). We provide water, wheelbarrows and hoses. You supply your own tools, seeds and labor. A garden supervisor is available to assist gardeners with questions or concerns.

2012 Growing Season: March 4–November 4

Gardeners can begin as soon as they have received their plot number confirmation. Remember **plot numbers are in the SOUTHEAST Corner**. Refer to the plot map on the Garden Kiosk for guidance.

Gardeners must have their plots cleared of all plant and non-plant material and returned to a level state by 4pm November 4th. Perennial Gardeners that do not plan on returning must also clear their plots.
