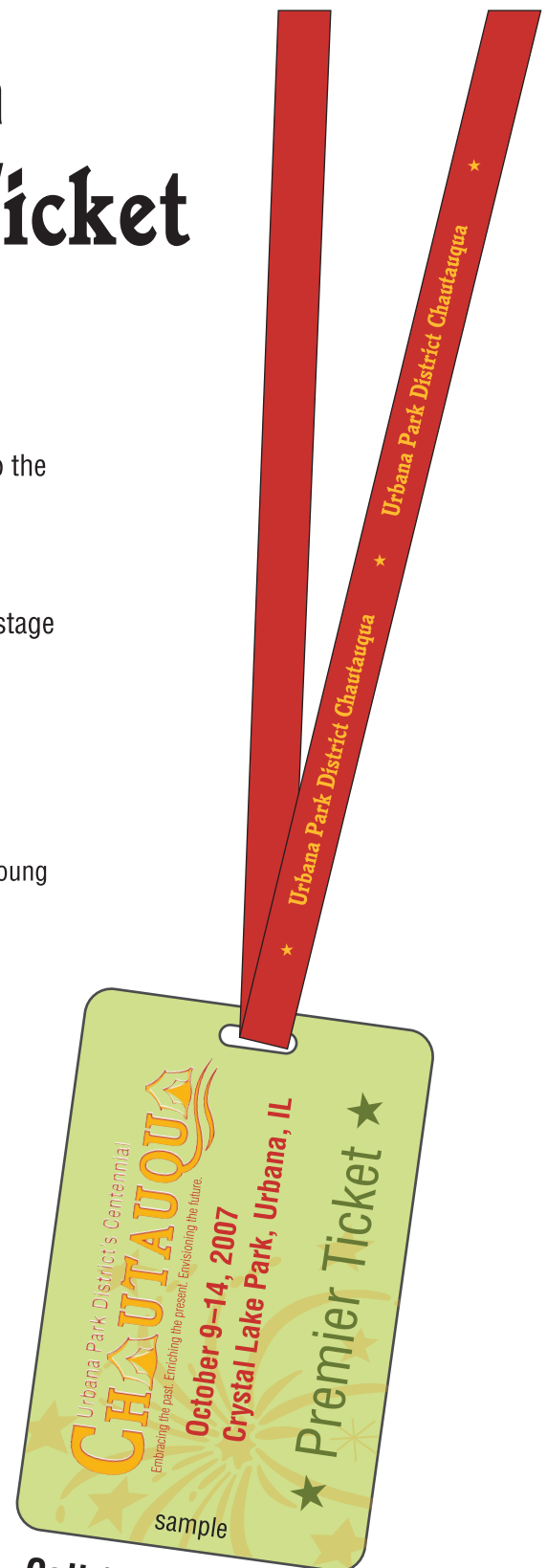

## Premier Parking Bonus

Purchase two or more **Premier Tickets** by September 10, 2007 and you may also purchase one **Premier Parking Pass** for an additional \$15. This pass guarantees a parking space within one block of the event for all Chautauqua performances.

### September 11 or later

If purchasing a Premier Ticket September 11 or later, you will pay \$75 per Premier Ticket. Premier Parking Passes will be \$25 each, (while supplies last). Premier Extras not included.

## General Ticket Rules

- Limit of six tickets per person.
- No refunds.
- Urbana Park District is not responsible for lost or stolen tickets. They will not be replaced.
- Advance tickets will be on sale through October 5, 2007. Any remaining tickets will go on sale at the Chautauqua information tent beginning October 9, 2007.
- Premier Tickets and Premier Parking Passes will not be mailed. Any phoned in orders can be picked up according to the instructions listed below.
- The Urbana Park District reserves the right to remove any disruptive attendee at the district's discretion.
- You must carry your ticket at all times.

### Until October 5, 2007

If ordering with a credit card by phone, you may pick up your Premier Ticket/parking passes at the Phillips Recreation Center, 505 W. Stoughton, Urbana, IL. Monday–Thursday 8am to 6pm, Friday 8am to 5pm, and Saturday 8am to Noon. Must bring a photo I.D. or your purchase confirmation.

### October 9 or later

1. Any tickets or parking passes purchased October 9 or later will be available for pick up on the first day of the Chautauqua—October 9, 2007. If you purchased a Premier Parking Pass, you may only park in your guaranteed space once you have your parking pass displayed in your car.

2. Pick up your tickets/parking passes at the “Will-Call” line at the Chautauqua Information Tent in Crystal Lake Park. “Will-Call” line will be open:

**Tuesday–Friday, October 9–12:** 5pm to 8pm

**Saturday, October 13:** 10am to 8pm

**Sunday, October 14:** Noon to 1pm

## Seating at the Event

- If you must leave your seat for any reason, please be sure your seatmate holds your seat for you so it is there upon your return. Be sure to take your ticket with you for re-entry to the Premier Ticket seating area.
- You may enter the Premier Ticket seating area 30 minutes before show time.
- **You are not assigned a specific seat, but are guaranteed a seat in the Premier Ticket section by the designated seating time if you are holding your Premier Ticket numbered 001–400. Those seating times are:**

**October 9:** 6:15pm

**October 12:** 6:45pm

**October 10:** 6:45pm

**October 13:** 6:45pm

**October 11:** 7:45pm

**October 14:** 12:45pm

**If you are not in your seat by the times listed above, your seat will be released.**
