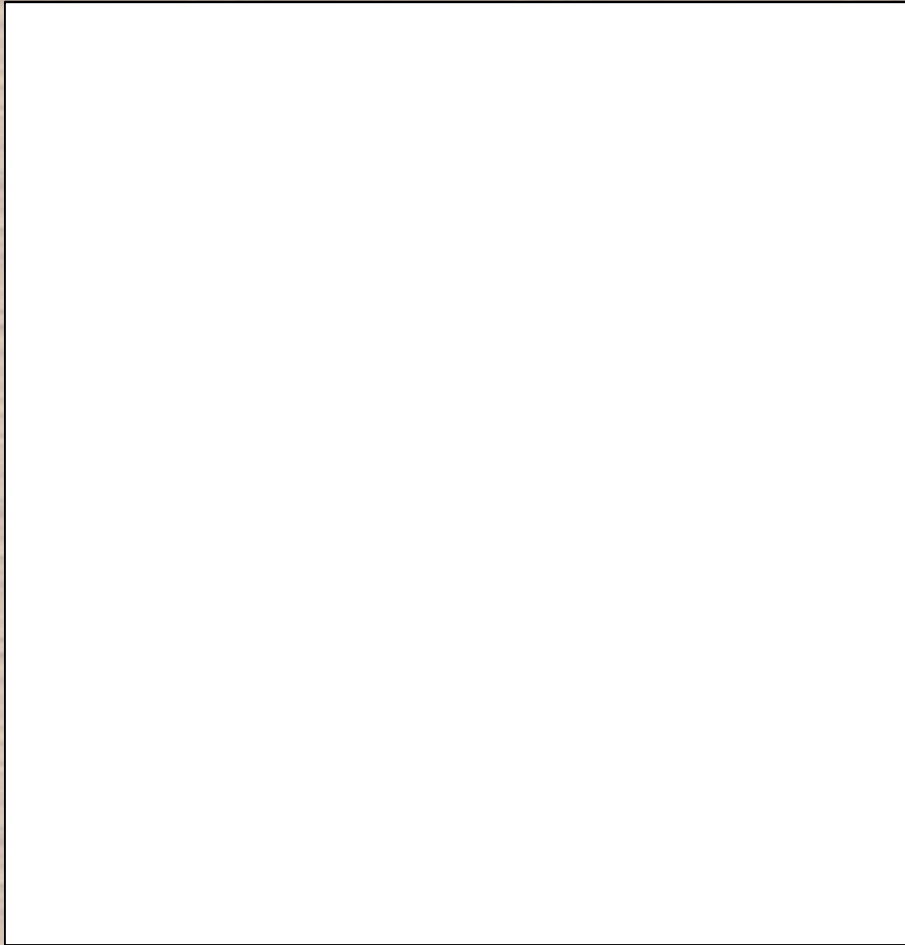

Use the crayons to complete a tree bark rubbing in the space below!

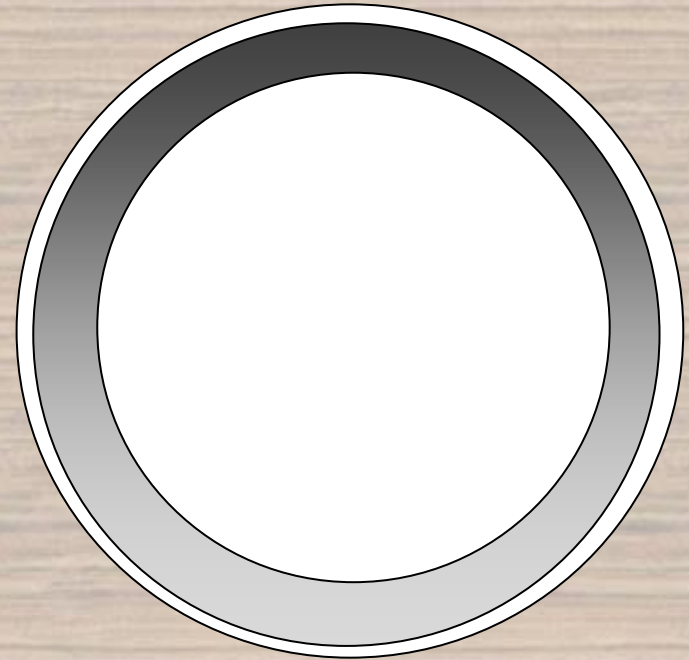


What tree is the bark from?
