The metal structures used are too hot to play on in the summer, and too cold to use in the winter-- which means the structures themselves, other than the swings, the rope climbing structure, and the merry-go-round, are hardly, if ever, used. The structures aren't conducive to imaginative play, and therefore often go untouched, where the old Carle Park playground was used by children and students of all age ranges, very commonly for collaborative play. The wooden structures at Meadowbrook currently fulfill a similar role as the old Carle structure. They aren't cookie-cutter to the point of being unenjoyable, and their hidden areas are used often for imaginative and collaborative play. The wood also doesn't fall to the issues of temperature which means that play is possible during a larger range of seasons. Please, as a student and long-time enjoyer of the parks, who now is witnessing a complete ambivalence to the new play structure that Carle implemented from a younger generation, don't just go with pre-built climbing and park setups, built from metal and plastic.
